Dancalan Mission

Shatin Church is sending a group of people at the end of March to serve the Dancalan Christian Church in the Philippines. Get to know more about this mission trip and how you can support the team below!



Where is Dancalan?

Dancalan is located in the southern part of the Philippines facing the Pacific Ocean. The Dancalan Christian Church was built after Shatin Church's mission trip there in 2007. This year's

team will return to serve the village people of Dancalan. Most of the residents are fishermen. The youth normally go to Manila to look for jobs after attaining their education. You can easily imagine how hard life is in the village, but people live simply and are happy.

What will the team be doing?

We've done this before and we are excited to do it again. We will also be doing bible studies with the adults and encouraging the workers. We will not only build up the church there spiritually, but also in practical ways. Some of the practical ways include installing new solar lights in the village, as well as painting the church building. A total of eleven of us are going (four young people and seven adults from Shatin Church). If there is anyone who is interested he/she can still join.

How can we pray for the team and the trip?

- We are still in need financially for the Mission trip and some members are really tight on money
- Safety, protection, good health and smooth travel for all of us a team
- That God will open the hearts of the people in the village and neighboring places
- Team unity and submissive heart

How were you led to retire in Thailand?

Several years ago, we each realised that we did not want to return to the UK. Needless to say, we began asking the Lord for his leading - is what we are sensing, from the Lord? Where does God want us to be? Over a period of time, under His leading, we were drawn to Thailand.

We narrowed it down to two places, Chiang Mai or Hua Hin. We knew that there is about 7000-8000 expats living in Hua Hin and in our visits, we began to see the need and have a heart to be part of His plan for this city. After much prayer and laying down our own wills and desires to Him, it finally became clear that Hua Hin was the place He had chosen for us. In our devotions, He



has said we will be light in a dark place. Our hearts are just to be where He wants us be, reaching out to those He puts in our path.

Looking back on our lives, we saw His preparation in our early lives and for our future. We look on our past experiences as part of His plan in preparing us for continuing to live in a new international environment.

How will you spend your time in retirement?

Overall, it is too early to say, but initially, finding our way about the town, finding the best places to shop/eat, and hopefully, beginning to learn to speak some Thai. (Patti is looking forward to cooking in a Western kitchen with a lot of counter space!). We look forward to meeting our neighbours and establishing contact with expat Christians, and also being a witness to those who would otherwise have no other opportunity to hear about Him.

What have been some of your favourite memories of life in Hong Kong?

This church has been a profound blessing to us. I [Patti] have especially loved my time with the Philippines Fellowship, and we have both been blessed to be part of our amazing Links Group where we grow together. Also being able to work in a truly Christian School is the greatest privilege! Every year I [Patti] have a about 22-26 precious treasures to disciple, love, and pray for. It has been a life transforming experience for me.

Lastly, we love Asia and the culture here in this part of the world, which means we have really enjoyed travelling, especially to Malaysia and Thailand.
